STUDENTS' ACHIEVEMENTS

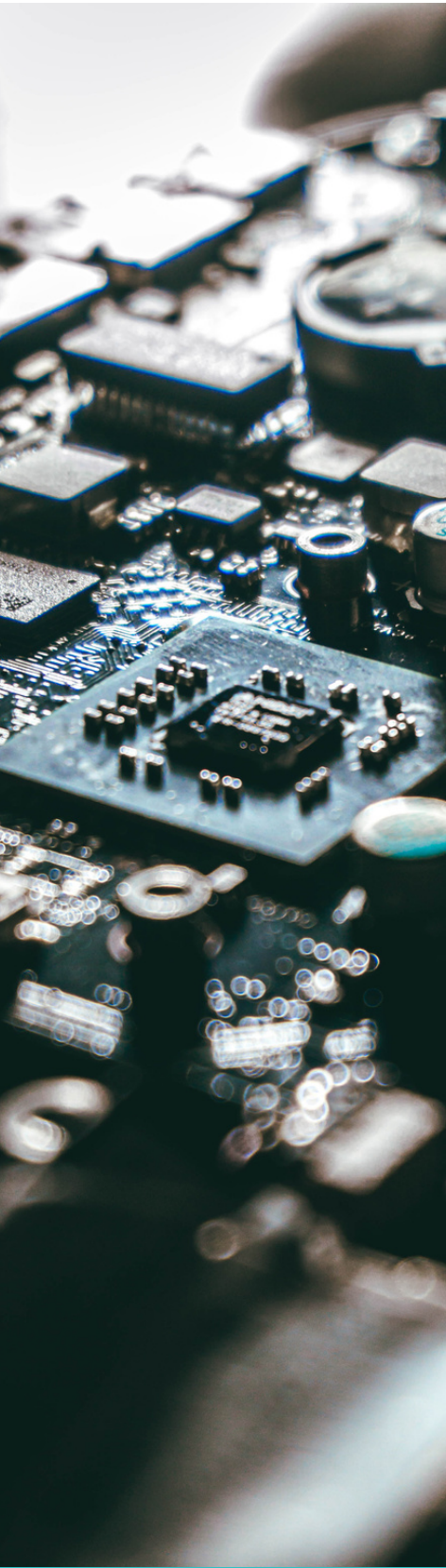
